

THE H.O.P.E. COMMITTEE: 2020 CHRISTMAS BASKETS AND ADOPT-A-CHILD CAMPAIGN

Given the current pandemic restrictions, we will not be collecting canned goods nor other food items for this year's Christmas Baskets. As an alternative, we will be providing families with food vouchers/gift cards to grocery stores.

As of two weeks ago, we have up to 26 families in need listed, including 78 children. As with the food baskets, we will not be purchasing presents this year. We will offer instead gift cards from retail stores *Toys 'R' Us* or *Walmart*. Our goal is to give a \$25 gift card to every child on the list. We encourage you to adopt a child or perhaps more than one if you have the means this Christmas season. Your monetary donation will go towards funding this project and will be included in your tax receipts for 2020.

The members of H.O.P.E. will be purchasing all the food vouchers and gift cards. We want to help keep everyone safe and avoid having our parishioners go to the stores. Given that our deadline to mail the gift cards to families is Thursday, December 10., we kindly ask that you make your donations to H.O.P.E. by Sunday. December 6.

It is only through our St. Aloysius parishioners that we are able to realize projects such as these. If you would like to help us with the food baskets, please continue to support H.O.P.E. through your weekly donations. Thank you for your generosity.
