

GAUDETE SUNDAY Simple Advent, Abundant Life: rejoice always

REFLECT

"As the earth brings forth its plants, and a garden makes its growth spring up, so will the Lord GOD make justice and praise spring up before all the nations." - Isaiah 61: 11 "Rejoice always." - 1 Thessalonians 5:16

On the third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday, we pause to celebrate that the coming of Jesus and God's justice are near. Gaudete is a Latin word meaning "rejoice," and as we take this moment to pause in the middle of Advent, we remember that true and lasting joy comes from God and through love of neighbor, not from discounts or the material presents that we give or receive. Advent simplicity provides an opportunity to reorient ourselves toward joy and to give thanks for the abundance of gifts already present in our lives.

On this Gaudete Sunday, how can you make space to rejoice and express gratitude for the gifts already present in your life?

ACT

Consider calling a loved one and expressing your gratitude for them or making a list of things for which you are grateful that you can uplift in prayer.

PRAY

Let us remember each other, and the needs of the world in our prayer this week. We remember also that we belong to a loving community of prayer that longs for and trusts in the light of Christ, even in the midst of the dark winter nights and difficult times in which we live.

So may our hearts and lives proclaim with every fibre of our being ... 'Reioice! The Lord is near!'

UPDATE FROM THE H.O.P.E. COMMITTEE: 2020 CHRISTMAS BASKETS AND ADOPT-A-CHILD CAMPAIGN

Given the current pandemic restrictions, we opted not to collect canned goods nor other food items for this year's Christmas Baskets. As an alternative, we are currently preparing to provide families with food vouchers/gift cards to grocery stores. To date, we have up to 28 families in need listed, including 81 children. As Christmas approaches, it is not unusual to receive later requests from families

The Adopt-A-Child campaign was very successful, as well as the Christmas Basket fund collection. We are pleased to announce that each of the 81 children will be receiving a gift card from either of the following retail stores, *Toys 'R' Us* or *Walmart*, depending on their age. All grocery gift cards have been purchased for the 28 families as well.
