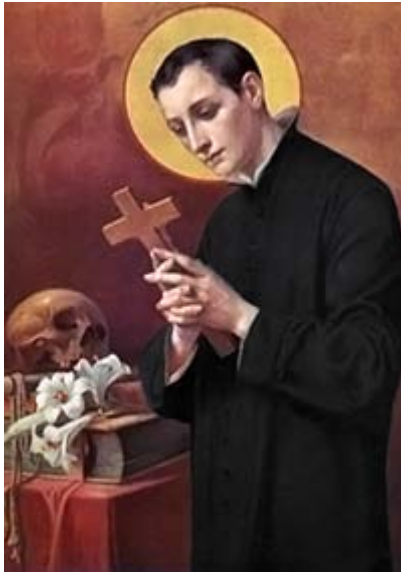

First Sunday of Lent

Our focus this Lent is on "Stewardship". During Advent we constructed our Road of Hope, paved with our path of prayer, that challenged us to welcome Christ into our lives, heart and mind. As we journey this Lent through the Gospels of Matthew and John, it gives us wonderful opportunity to journey again along our Road of Hope and focus on our paths of prayer, for us to truly open ourselves to become the Stewards of God that He calls us to be. Throughout all the readings of the gospels, we will see Temptation, Change, Centering our lives in prayer, Blindness, Unwillingness and Gratefulness. At the end of our journey this Lenten season, hopefully together through prayer and reflection, we will all come to allow God to create a clean heart within us that reflects God's call of being His stewards to both ourselves and others.

Stewardship Bulletin Reflection for the Week

Today's readings present us with two different accounts of temptations that could lead us to not being good stewards. God had put the man in the garden to care for it, to be its steward. In return, God told the man he could eat the fruit of all the trees except one, the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. But when tempted by the serpent to eat the fruit from that one tree, the humans ate it, showing they were not trustworthy stewards. The result was separation from God and death.

On the other hand, when Satan tempted Jesus, He held firm. He showed He was a good steward of treasure, by not using it for His own comfort (refusing to turn stones into bread). He proved He was a good steward of talent, by not using His abilities for his own glory (refusing to jump from the parapet of the Temple). He was a good steward of time, which is to be used to worship only the true God (refusing to fall down in worship before Satan). He maintained this faithfulness throughout His ministry, being obedient even to a death on the cross.

By this obedience, Paul wrote to the Romans that Jesus conquered death, the result of Adam's sin. This Lent, let us use the grace God offers us, so we ourselves can be obedient stewards of the time, talent, and treasure entrusted to us, in accordance with the call of Christ in our lives.
