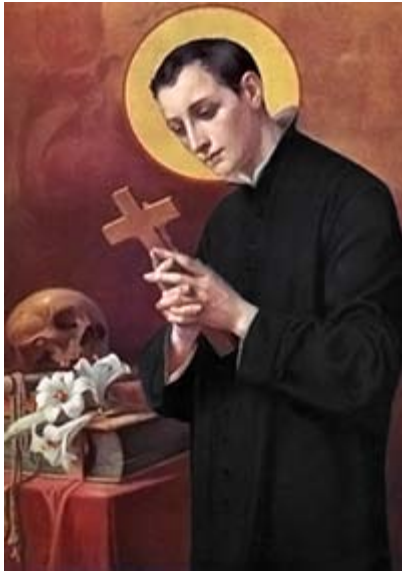

This Week's Stewardship Reflection

Just before His Ascension, Jesus charged the apostles with the task of spreading the Gospel to the whole world. At the time, they did not know exactly what He meant and how they would do it. But at His Ascension, Jesus resumed His heavenly glory and began His ministry of intercession for us. He then sent the Holy Spirit to empower, guide, and sanctify the Church.

In carrying out His commission, the apostles found they had received the resources they needed. They spent their time in prayer, their talent to find how to most effectively communicate the good news of Jesus, and their treasure in undertaking the work. We also have our part. We have the responsibility to pray for missionaries and their work, to seek to understand and share our Faith, and to give support to the work of the Church throughout the world. Thus, we too participate in the commission Christ left His Church.

The Ascension of the Lord – Feast Day

(Thursday after the sixth Sunday of Easter or on the seventh Sunday of Easter)

The Feast of the Ascension is celebrated on the fortieth day after Easter Sunday, commemorating the Ascension of Christ into Heaven and His completion of the work of our redemption. The liturgy on this day celebrates the entry of Christ into heaven with our human nature glorified, and the pledge of our glorification with Him. In the past, processions outside the church were held on this day to imitate Christ's leading the Apostles out of the city to the Mount of Olives, and to commemorate the entry of Christ into heaven.
