



#### CHURCH OPEN FOR EASTER

Following a decree adopted March 24 by the Quebec government and diocesan announcements released March 25, a maximum of 250 participants (subject to space available in accordance with public health guidelines) are permitted in liturgical celebrations in places of worship located in red zones as of Friday, March 26.

Thanks to our team of volunteers, public Mass is offered at 9:30 a.m. for Palm Sunday, March 28 and Easter Sunday, April 4 at Ste-Louise-de-Marillac Church (7901 Ste-Claire St.). Doors open at 9:15 a.m. An email to this effect was sent through the parish contact list on March 25. If you would like to be included in this email list, please contact the parish office.

#### Registration required

The maximum number of people that can be safely accommodated per celebration at Ste-Louise-de-Marillac is 40. Registrations for Church Sunday Mass will be taken on a firstcome, first-served basis. To do so, please call the office at 514-351-3281 and leave your name with Joanne, as well as those of any other family members who will be attending. This will help facilitate contact-tracing should the need arise. Joanne requests to please not send any messages to the parish Facebook page to reserve your place.

#### Important reminders

- In compliance with required health safety measures, entry to the church will be restricted to the main doors on Honoré-Beaugrand St. (corner Ste-Claire St.)
- Please take your seat immediately upon arrival. Physical distancing of two meters between people from different households must be maintained at all times, as does the compulsory wearing of standard procedural masks to be provided.

#### Important reminders (cont'd)

 Departure: After Mass, everyone must exit the church by the side doors located at the north-end of the building (either side of the sanctuary).

We thank you for your patience and collaboration in helping ensure the safety of staff, volunteers and parishioners as we enter into this next phase of liturgical life.
