


"Even the most hardened sinner, if he recites this chaplet even once, will receive grace from My Infinite Mercy" (Diary, 687).

#### **CHURCH OPEN**

Following the recent tightening of restrictions announced April 6 by the Quebec government and diocesan announcements released April 8, attendance is now limited to a maximum of 25 participants in liturgical celebrations in places of worship located in red zones as of last Thursday.

Thanks to our team of volunteers, Mass is open to the public Sundays at 9:30 a.m. at Ste-Louise-de-Marillac Church (7901 Ste-Claire St.). Doors open at 9:15 a.m.

#### Registration required

The maximum number of people permitted per celebration at Ste-Louise-de-Marillac Church is 25. Registrations for Sunday Mass will be taken on a first-come, first-served basis. To do so, please call the office at 514-351-3281 and leave your name with Joanne, as well as those of any other family members who will be attending. This will help facilitate contact-tracing should the need arise. Joanne requests to please not send any messages to the parish Facebook page to reserve your place.

#### Important reminders

- In compliance with required health safety measures, entry to the church will be restricted to the main doors on Honoré-Beaugrand St. (corner Ste-Claire St.)
- Please take your seat immediately upon arrival. Physical distancing of two meters between people from different households must be maintained at all times, as does the compulsory wearing of standard procedural masks, to be provided.

#### Important reminders (cont'd)

 Departure: After Mass, everyone must exit the church by the side doors located at the north-end of the building (either side of the sanctuary).

We thank you for your patience and collaboration in helping ensure the safety of staff, volunteers and parishioners as we enter into this next phase of liturgical life.
