



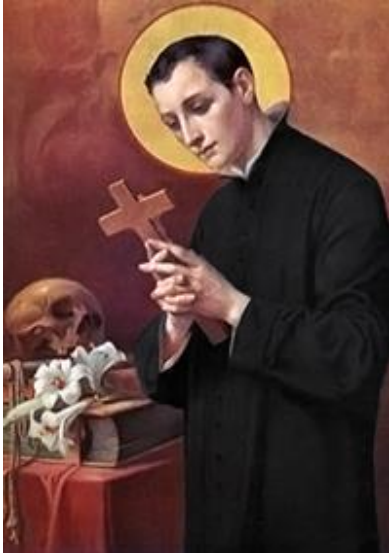

### The Mission of the Twelve

Mark 6: 7-13

**Reflection:**

The teaching that God's love is present in welcoming strangers and neighbours has been a strong belief of many cultures. The Indian writer, Rabindranath Tagore, tells us that when people left his hut, he found "God's footsteps on the floor". The Divine lives in each of us, and when we welcome each other we welcome God, and Jesus, the Son of God. This is the welcome of the church to all. Too often the church has been choosy about who to welcome or not welcome to the table of the Lord or even to the community. Our country can be overly particular in welcoming the stranger in need. A call to the church today is to welcome all and be enriched by the variety of prayer, friendship and worship which all can bring.

Since Montreal and Laval regions transitioned to green zone status on **Monday, June 28, registration to attend Mass is no longer mandatory.**

Thanks to our team of volunteers, Mass is open to the public Sundays at 9:30 a.m. at Ste-Louise-de-Marillac Church (7901 Ste-Claire St.). Doors open at 9:15 a.m.

Because the green zone status remains at a "Level One Alert for Covid-19 : Vigilance", several safety measures continue to be implemented until further notice.

- **Registration is no longer required**
- Wearing of standard procedural masks remains obligatory and safe physical distancing will continue to be implemented indoors.
- As announced at Mass, please remember that singing during Mass is still not permitted.
