





## 29<sup>th</sup> SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

### The Request of James and John

Mark 10:35-45

#### Reflection:

- The request of the apostles James and John brings to light our natural desires to be approved of and rewarded in worldly terms. Jesus tells us his meaning of real greatness – service and the care of others. Realizing that Jesus is our servant is what helps us to be servants to others.
- Already Jesus knows that he must endure suffering and a cruel death. This is the “cup” which he asks to be spared in Gethsemane. The brothers seem to have no problem at all about accepting this cup; do they even know what they are saying?
- This dialogue leads us deep into Jesus' way of teaching. Jesus leads James and John into the implications of what they are asking, inviting them to resist the clumsy ambition of worldly greatness.

### THE H.O.P.E. COMMITTEE: PREPARATIONS FOR CHRISTMAS FUNDRAISER

Plans are underway for our annual Christmas Basket and Adopt-a-Child Campaign. As with last year, H.O.P.E. will be taking care of providing gift cards from *President's Choice®*, *Toys'R'Us®* and *Walmart®* to less fortunate families in our community. We have contacted two local schools and are awaiting a list of families in need. In addition to young families, we also provide for adults who are in need.

Once again, we are turning to you, our parishioners and friends, for your help.

Last year we provided food gift cards for approximately 30 families and gift cards for presents for up to 70 children. In total we raised \$7,473.00. Without your generosity, this would have been an impossible endeavor.

Proceeds from H.O.P.E.'s weekly collections will go towards funding our Christmas Baskets outreach project. Once the number of children on our list is confirmed, we will launch our Adopt-A-Child campaign. We will be collecting cash donations only - \$25.00 per child. We will purchase the gift cards on your behalf.

Our goal is to deliver Christmas greeting cards with these gift cards enclosed, no later than **Saturday, December 11**, in order for families to have time to use them for their Christmas shopping.

We are truly grateful for the support of our St. Aloysius family, without whom none of this is possible. We look to you again this year to help us bring cheer to these deserving families.
