The Proclamation of John the Baptist

Luke 3:10-18

Reflection:

- This week, we continue to hear about John the Baptist and our role to spread the message. As Christians, whether lay persons, religious or priests, we are called to bring people face to face with Christ and also to a conversion that brings a real joy and happiness into their lives.
- Christ needs our co-operation in this mission. He works through parents, teachers, ministers etc., everyone who has a call to form others. The people ask John, "what should we do?" His answer is surprisingly ordinary: share with others; don't cheat; be honest, don't exploit/oppress people. How might we embrace the sacred in the ordinary, and the ordinary in the sacred? What does my lifestyle say about my faith in Christ? How can I bring the divine into my ordinary actions and make my faith a living thing?
- What must I do to prepare to meet the Messiah?
