

EDITORIAL OF BROTHER MATHIEU

As some of you know, I translate into English the various texts that Brother Jacques Mathieu, Capuchin, writes for the Saint Thérèse Missionary Centre. He graciously allows me to use my translation of his texts for our Bulletin. Here is his editorial for the coming year's magazine:

«I decided to ask myself what it is that makes me either sad or happy.

To tell the truth, the present wars leave me speechless: Ukraine, Gaza, even Haiti, all while being conscious that, in Africa there are great sufferings and displacements.

What gives me joy and hope is human nature and the increasing presence of the Creator and Father of all.

Here in Canada and Quebec, the arrival of many immigrants tells me that a great change is coming: diversity of cultures, religions, languages and the birth of a new society. «I do not see life like before», says the song. My certainties of yesteryear are unravelling: «When nothing is certain, what can the just do? » says the psalm.

What I see as positive are God's excesses, the shepherd who leaves 99 lambs to look for the 100th which got lost. Or again, the fellow who gives the same wage to the one who worked just one hour while others laboured all day. Again, very positive is the heart of God who asks me not to judge... just like He who does not judge but saves. I could also see a third evidence, concerning the Church, God's House, God's table, open to all!

Yes, there is kindness in the heart of man created in God's image. Think of all the workers who give of themselves for others in different domains: sanitation, health, education, food, construction... Thanks!

What should I do to make my life meaningful? Give, give of oneself, share, love, forgive... You have the words of eternal life! To whom shall we go?

Is it good and necessary to believe in God? I would say «Yes» more and more! Because God is Love and the key which gives life meaning...the key which gives meaning to the existence of the universe.

In closing, I see the importance of leaving out that which shackles us: the smallness of the Earth and of the Universe compared to what is above all! We have no explanation if we do not believe in a Loving God, Creator of all that is! The Word of God tells us that the material and the visible are nothing but a dream, a thought of God, an image of God. What is left of man, is his soul, «anima», called to eternal life outside of time and space... on a new Earth and under new skies.

Because nothing is impossible for God! »
