

WHY PRAY?

As some of you know, I translate into English the various texts that Brother Jacques Mathieu, Capuchin, writes for the Saint Thérèse Missionary Centre. He graciously lets me use my translation of his texts for our Bulletin. Here is one of his articles for the coming year's magazine. It is on a very interesting subject, i.e. Prayer Transforms Solitude. It brings you in contact with the most important Person there is; so, you are never alone.

«Prayer, it is talking to God, most often to ask Him for something. If I believe in God, I am not alone! My life is permanently with another. (It is not good for man to be alone!) Half of the residences in Montreal are occupied by people who live alone. If God is accepted and welcomed, He becomes very important for the life, joy and equilibrium of that person.

So, why pray? What does prayer do in my life? Prayers mean that I have recognized a beneficent presence in me. I am attentive to this presence, I pay attention to this Person who is there, who is bigger than me and very real and I join this Person who prays in me, because Jesus talks to his Father and it is so marvellous.

Prayer can take place by itself in my heart. Prayer makes me attentive to others so as to understand them, to make me rejoice in the mystery of their existence. The Spirit of God prays in

me!

Prayer removes my worries from me. «Send me all your worries and I will care for you!» says Jesus. Being present to myself, my life is being built in peace. The great saints prayed constantly. «One must always pray without tiring» says the Lord. Saint Padre Pio never left his rosary and Saint Seraphim of Sarov used to say: «Prayer is a weapon close at hand. Ask and you shall receive.»

Francoise Hardy sang «One is very little... it's what my friend the rose told me this morning.» Yes, it is true, we are very little, but let us thank prayer which makes us see and understand that we are important in the heart of God.

What will I ask God? Why not the gift of

prayer? Ask that Jesus comes to pray in me like He used to do in the countryside of Palestine. Prayer is a great force that can transform the world. In it we become God's joy. We become the bearer of others by love and by prayer, in faithfulness every day! »
