OUR FATHER

As you know, during the Mass, we celebrate the «Our Father», the only prayer that Jesus taught us, by bringing the children around the altar to recite this prayer and then we send them, as Ambassadors of Peace, back into the congregation. This surely signifies an emphasis on this prayer, which comes so close to the partaking of Holy Communion.

Now, the two words, “Our Father”, which start the prayer are absolutely fundamental. One could even say they encapsulate our Faith: God is the Father, the Father of all of us. We are His children; we are all part of His family. We are not first and foremost individuals, we are first and foremost part of God’s family. We are God’s people, God’s assembly, the Church. Jesus was born to become our Brother, just like we were born to be God’s children.

As we all know, we can emulate the Holy Family, where Mary and Joseph looked after their Baby, Who, once grown, helped at home and in His father’s trade. Mary is not first and foremost an individual, but a wife and a mother, living in a community.

Why am I insisting on relationship? Very simply because God created us to develop in a community, not as individuals. «It is not good for man to be alone...»



Unfortunately, someone called René Descartes came up with «Cogito ergo sum», the greatest disaster in philosophy. The basic point is not, «I think, therefore I am»; rather, it is «Our Father». Every human being is part of something much greater, much more fundamental: a community, a country. That is why people are ready to die for their communities, for their countries. That is why we say that soldiers are serving their country, that we recognize their sacrifice, even when they survive their service.



We, as God’s children, must look after each other. That is our role, our duty! This is, among other things, why HOPE is so important. We have to reach out to others, even if they are not part of our congregation. As children of God, we must act like Him, never forgetting that He gave us an example so that we can follow in Jesus’ footsteps. More than that, He even went as far as to feed us with Himself, so we can really become more like Him in all things.

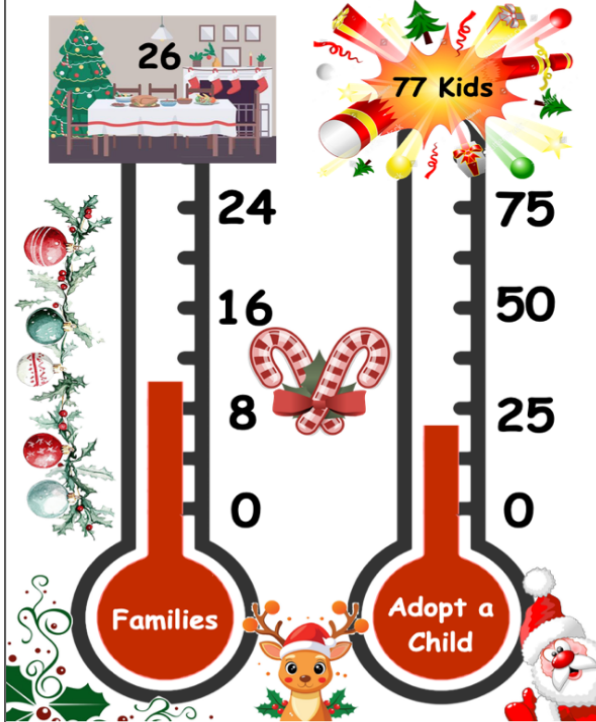
