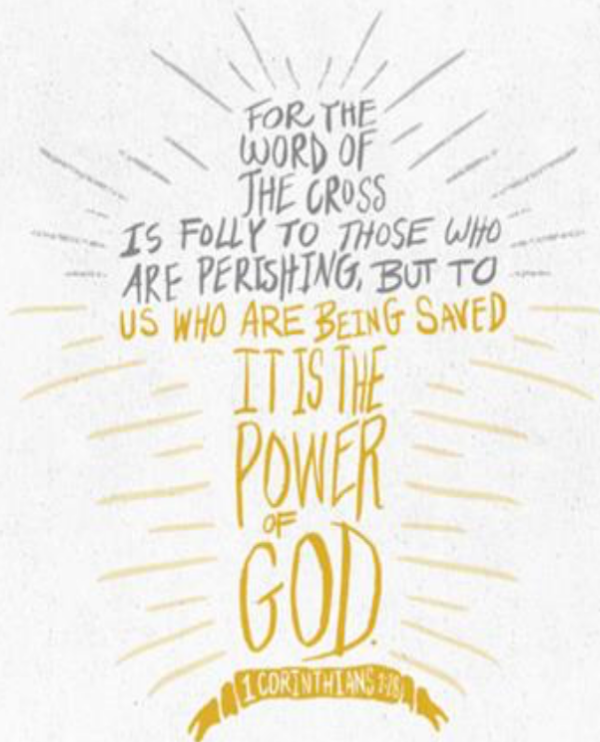

“BY HIS WOUNDS WE ARE HEALED.”

There is no Easter Sunday without Good Friday. The message of the Cross is the power of God, says St. Paul (1 Cor 1:18). In this Holy Year dedicated as the jubilee year of St. Francis of Assisi, I invite you to focus on the Cross of Jesus, which leads to the joy of His Resurrection, our life. Following Jesus closely in his life, St. Francis was given the gift bearing the wounds of Jesus, the Stigmata, in his body. The Sacred Scriptures say that 'by His wounds we are healed.' (Is 53:5, 1Pt 2:24). For those who don't have the gift of faith, pain and suffering are something negative, not acceptable, and have to be gotten rid of immediately. But for those who have the gift of faith, it is not like that. Bearing the wounds of Jesus in one's body, humanly speaking, is not 'a bed of roses', it is an agony beyond words, but spiritually speaking, it is an honour and gift. The Church has dedicated a whole year in honour of St. Francis of Assisi for bearing the honour of the stigmata of Jesus and accepting its pain. Let us ask St. Francis to intercede for us, so that, in the Resurrection of Jesus, we see the Cross and the pain He suffered for us, and accept our own cross and pain like Our Lady of Sorrows for the salvation of the world.
