## FROM THE SUMMER MAGAZINE OF THE STMC

Permit me this time to use some of my translations for the Summer Magazine of the Saint Thérèse Missionary Centre. At least, you have texts written by a priest rather than a lay person; and a Capuchin to boot, brother Jacques Mathieu.

«To start with, I welcome joyfully winter's end... a winter that has been long, cold, hard to take! The sun is taking more and more its place, all for the better. Wars we do not like continue to worry us. Which new World is coming forth?

Two words come to my mind: freedom and responsibility. Freedom of the Creator who, as He promised, is always with us. Freedom of the Creator who attracts to Himself whoever He wants. Freedom which applies to us as we are no longer attracted by a «socially» acceptable religion but freely we walk toward the Lord. «Do you want to leave me as well?» seems to say the Lord to us... «To whom would we go? You have the words of Eternal Life.» Yes, we will in an age where our responsibility is present and calls us to action.

Two other words that the Lord tells us: love and forgive! The marvellous Love emanating from God's heart Who makes His home in us. Thanks for the Eucharist which carries out God's promise to stay with us, Thanks for forgiveness, this gift of God, which helps us to accept ourselves as we are as well as every other person. Your love is for all since the beginning to the end of time.

Simple tips to act as a Christian: 1) Hospitality: to welcome to one's table friends or lonely people. The Emmaus disciples welcomed Jesus at their table that way. 2) Meeting: to see Jesus in everyone, to know that everyone is very dear to God's heart. No one is too much! 3) Listening: how many lonely people need to be listened to, to reveal themselves! Praise to the telephone! To the daily! To the banal! A brother missionary had this habit to call people on their birthdays... it brings some warmth to the heart! 4) Sharing: our surpluses often sleep and encumber us: «What you have done to the least, you have done unto me!» 5) Smile: easy, because the joy of the Holy Spirit is in us! 6) Walking: to find again health, peace and joy of life!»

Just to finish, one finds in the magazine a heart-breaking message from a Lebanese brother: «I want to send you my best wishes for the Feast of Easter... This is the day the Lord has made, let us rejoice and be glad... But for us, it has been a day of death under bombs, a day of grief and distress... But we believe in the Resurrection which helps us to always have faith and to live not only day to day, but war after war: that is Lebanon, where everything tumbles in an instant... but Jesus is there to help us rise and save this beautiful country which belongs to him...
