SAINT ANNE

Today is my birthday. I was born 80 years ago, before the Church started to make quite a few changes in the responsibilities put on the faithful and before renewals were introduced. It was in the period when Maurice Duplessis was still Premier of the Province, the period which is referred by quite a few as *la grande noirceur* (*The Great Darkness*). In those days, the Church's influence on the population was still quite great and the last Council had been Vatican I in 1870.

As some of us know, many saints were demoted with Vatican II (like Saint Philomena) and some changes were made to those referred to in the Sanctoral. But in 1946, only Saint Anne was mentioned on that day (otherwise I might have been called Joachim, just as I would have been called Anne had I been born a girl. Mother had to consult a bit more and found that calling me Jacques would put my name day just on the eve of my birthday.



As we all know, Anne was the mother of Mary. An important Shrine was built to her, somewhat East of Québec City. She is one of the Patron Saints of French Canada. Linda and I visited the shrine on our first trip to Québec City. (Jesus, of course, would have had a much simpler job of doing His genealogy as He only had to see only to His mother's side.)

Of course, we Catholics make a huge fuss about Mary, Jesus' mother. So do the Orthodox by the way. We all recognize that it is through Mary that Jesus was incarnated. Her importance is such that her parents are important. Just like the parents of Saint John the Baptist

are known and found in the Gospel, Elisabeth and Zechariah, tradition names those of Mary as Anne and Joachim.

In my first year at Oxford, in 1969 or 1970, there was a Plasma Physics Conference there with people from France among the attendants and I was chosen to help them. They were all gathered at Saint Anne's College, and so I resided there with them. In those days, there were very few colleges for women in Oxford, and Saint Anne's was one of them. (There was one woman for every 10 men at the time). I was to find out later that it was the college where my wife, Linda resided, just like I resided at Corpus Christi College, and it is my college's six-foot scarf that I wear for the second part of the Mass on Sundays...



You can now understand a bit why I am fond of Mary's mother; she has quite a few connotations for me.

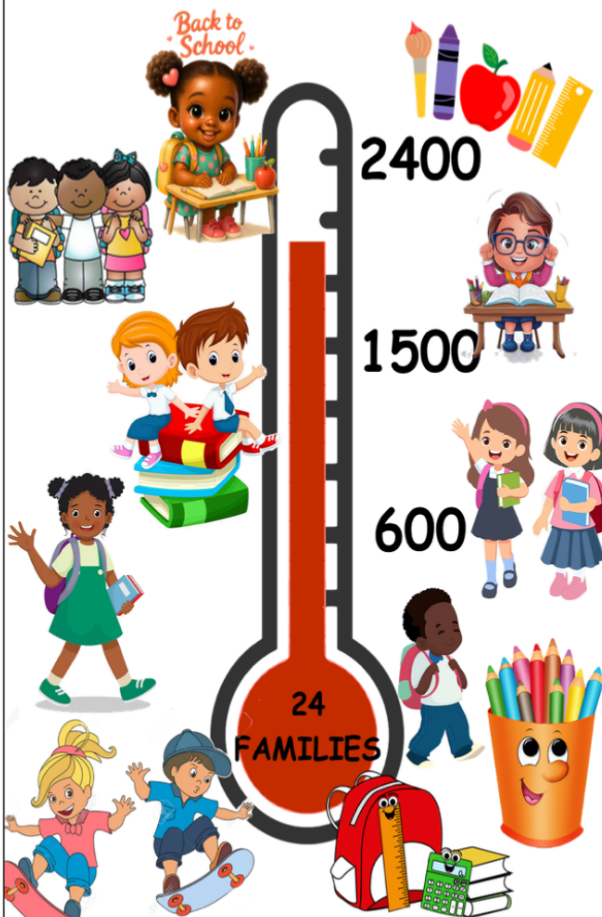
