

I shall continue to keep you all in my prayers as I hope you shall all continue to pray for me.

"Succeeding Father Paul Pomkoski at Saint Aloysius Parish", really? That someone would have told me this even two years ago would have seemed an impossible mission and a silly declaration to me. When, in 2014, I was nominated as responsible for Mary, Help of Christians Italian Mission of R.D.P., I remember telling a member of their young growing English community that "I was sent here because I speak Italian, not because I speak English". The above statement to introduce myself brings in the notions of obedience and of openness. I am delighted that this new challenge presented to me will hopefully lead us all to our Lord of the impossible.

Graduated from the Music Faculty in History at McGill University, I pursued a career as a baritone with the now defunct Tudor Singers of Montreal, under the direction of Wayne Riddell, in an exciting life, singing all over Canada. Of course, all was in English but I soon forgot it all, as I studied at the Grand-Séminaire de Montréal, for 5 years in French to become a priest. I was then 35 years old, after a long quest for meaning and was ready to begin a new life: existing for the others, and not being the



center of my own existence anymore. God has such a great sense of humour. As I was back at the Cathedral as Assistant to the Pastor, after being the chantre-animateur for 20 years, I slowly became ready to be sent as Pastor at Sainte-Angèle Parish, where the founding francophone community was open to welcoming the Italian speaking community. It is through the love of the Italian language and culture that this challenge led me to Maria Ausiliatrice as pastor.

Together with Father Donbosco Mawdsley, s.m.a., at Maria Ausiliatrice and at the Italian San Domenico Savio Mission, we shall, with you, join in for the realization of St. Aloysius mission statement: that "inspired by the Holy Spirit, strive to live our Baptismal Promises by using our time, talent and treasure to reach out to others as Jesus did."
